Eagle Encounters is proud to announce it's first Art Auction / Fundraising event to be held on the 20th October 2010.

The theme of the exhibition is "**Art in appreciation of our beautiful Birds of Prey**". Our vision is to present quality works of art in an array of mediums that deliver a conservation message by drawing attention to South African Birds of Prey.

We invite artists from of the area to submit works of art, be it sculpture, painting, photography, jewellery, craft or accessory. Realistic or abstract. Inspired specifically by SOUTH AFRICAN Birds of Prey.

All artwork will be assessed before exhibition to ensure that we not only present quality art to the public but that we deliver the relevant message.

Artists are encouraged to include a synopsis of 250 words outlining the central idea for each artwork.

Artworks will be sold in silent action at the event. A minimum sale price for artworks may be set by the artist. If an artwork is sold, and on receipt of payment, **the artist will be entitled to 40% of the sale price** - the remaining amount will be donated to Eagle Encounters. The artists name will be displayed on an events sponsor board and on our website with relevant links to the artist's website or contact details.

Should an artwork not sell at the fundraising event, there will be an opportunity for the work to remain on sale at our shop at Eagle Encounters, the Heath, Plettenberg Bay for 3 months.

Entry form must reach us by 15th September 2010
Artwork must reach us by 14th October 2010

Date for final selection judging is 15th October 2010. *Artists will be telephoned with results*

Unsuccessful works must be collected from us on the 16th/17th October 2010

The judges' decision is final and no correspondence with the organisers will be allowed.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Subject matter is to be inspired by South African Birds of Prey
- Only original completed works may be entered.
- Entries in any medium may be entered.
- Works may not be dangerous or potentially dangerous
- The artist's name, address and telephone number, and the title, medium and minimum selling price of the work must be clearly written on the back of the work.
- The top end of the work must be indicated by an arrow to avoid uncertainty and errors.
- All works for hanging must be properly framed or stretched on a sturdy stretcher frame.
- Artworks must be supplied with two 10mm screw eyes and hanging wire, attached to the vertical sides at about a quarter of the full length from the top of the work.
- A hanging work may not weigh more than 10kg.
- Delicate or fragile works must be clearly indicated as such and may require installation by the artist.
- Sculptures must be able to stand firmly and must be stable.

LIABILITY

Accepted works will not be insured whilst in the possession of Eagle Encounters. Artists are encouraged to self-insure their pieces. Although all works will receive care and the usual safety precautions will apply, the organisers will take no responsibility for damage to, or loss of, works during or after the exhibition.
